PURPOSE

Busy Bees Early Learning Australia aim to promote children's general wellbeing by creating an environment that supports healthy dental and oral health habits and practices that can be maintained throughout a child's life. We will provide food and drinks with consideration to the sugar content and ensure children always have access to fresh drinking water throughout the day and after meals.

SCOPE

Children, Busy Bees Employees, Management, and Families

POLICY

Busy Bees Early Learning Australia believe it is important for all children to practice a high level of dental hygiene and will follow the guidelines of the Australian Dental Association and State Government Health Departments when caring for children's teeth.

To minimise the risk of cavities forming, we encourage children to eat nutritious foods and to avoid sticky and sugary foods. All food served and prepared at our Services comply with these guidelines by providing a variety of recommended vegetables, fruit, and dairy products.

Busy Bees will adhere to recommendations from organisations such as *Munch and Move* and *Get Up and Grow,* and recognised authorities, and engage with dental professionals to enhance the inclusion of dental education into the Service and everyday programs.

All employees will ensure children have access to fresh drinking water and will encourage them to drink water throughout the day and after all meals.

We provide information and guidelines on good dental health practices, which are implemented into daily routines, including providing information about brushing teeth and teeth friendly snacks and drinks, going to the dentist, and encouraging children who are capable to rinse their mouth through the swish and swallow technique after mealtimes if there is no tooth brushing program in the Service. Services implementing tooth brushing will have an approved program and children will be encouraged to brush their teeth after meals.

Children will not be put to bed or into a cot with a bottle, all bottles must be consumed before a child or baby is put to bed under supervision. Where appropriate, water will be offered to the child before going to bed. Dummies will not be dipped in any substance prior to being given to a child.

Busy Bees will ensure compliance with first aid qualifications ensuring a qualified employee is always on duty to follow appropriate procedures in the event of dental accidents and emergencies. We will endeavour to record on enrolment the name, address, and phone number of each child's dentist.
